APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Children applying for Kindergarten must be 5 years of age by September 30th of the year of entry. Similarly, children applying for the 3-year-old program, must be 3 years of age, and the 4-year-old program must be 4 years of age by September 30th.

Checklist of forms that must be submitted before acceptance:

- Application with \$50 non-refundable application fee
- Copy of Baptismal Certificate and/or relevant sacramental documentation (Catholics only)
- Original Birth Certificate (presented for verification only)
- Copy of most recent report card and testing records
- Proof of custody where applicable

Additionally, the following must be submitted:

- Parish Registration Verification form
 - Student Evaluation form

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Saint Ann Catholic School is now accepting applications for the 2017-2018 school year. Applications with the \$50 application fee may be submitted in-person or by mail. **We will begin processing applications for the new school year on January 30, 2017.**

Saint Ann Catholic School sets registration procedures and admission policies. The availability of space and the order of preference for admission is determined by the school according to the following general criteria:

- Children currently enrolled in Saint Ann Catholic School
- Siblings of children currently enrolled in Saint Ann Catholic School
- Children from Saint Ann parish
- Military Families
- Children from neighboring parishes
- Children from other families

Notification of acceptance will be sent after all required paperwork is received.

Once your application has been accepted, a letter of acceptance, a registration form and a Records Release Form (except for Kindergarten) will be sent to you. A non-refundable deposit of \$500.00 will be required at that time.

Saint Ann may require readiness screening. Parents may also request readiness screening for their child.
